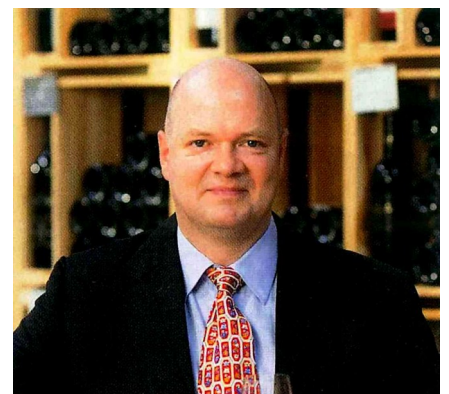

Intense ruby colour, beautiful aromas of citrus fruits, orange peel with ripe wild raspberries and morello cherries. Extremely delicate floral notes with a hint of mushroom flavours. Already extremely attractive and drinkable now. Medium to full bodied wine, showing ripe morello cherries on the palate, which are supported by a wonderful lively and fresh acidity. Showing minerality and elegance, spicy in the finish then earthy undertones and a firm, but very approachable tannin structure.
