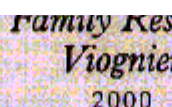

It is very much a complex chardonnay with interesting secondary components and an appealing grip to the palate which features fully ripe fruit and well handled oak. (\$NZ25.00)

## SHIRAZ



**2000 SCHUBERT TRIBIANCO** A unique blend of müller-thurgau, chardonnay and pinot gris, this blend has good fruit intensity and acid balance in a somewhat Italianate style. (\$NZ20.00)

**1999 SCHUBERT SYRAH** This New Zealander is very, very shiraz - all licorice and spice. The tannins are a little chewy and need time to soften. (\$NZ45.00)
