Schubert Tribianco 2002

Chardonnay, pinot gris and Muller Thurgau in a delightful easy style, low oak, almost dry white and quite satisfying. Complete, ready for relaxing or light-medium food flavours. \$20

Schubert Pinot Noir 2002

Gutsy pinot, 14.5% alcohol and with a lot to say! Overtly young, intense and hearty in its flavours, a wine needing air time before drinking to enjoy its strength and statement. Or wait for 2006. \$48

Schubert Marion's Vineyard Pinot Noir 2002

★★★★

Nicely supple and flavoursome, although needing more bottle age to show its best. Lighter in body than the more expensive brother above, but working very well as a sound, all-purpose style. Open from mid-2004. \$35
