## 2015 Schubert Block B Pinot Noir

*“Sophisticated and elegant bouquet with an earthy, fruity, new, sweet cashew nut-like oak – youthful with a vibrant and urgent attack. On the palate – dry, varietal, packed with flavours of red berry fruits, strawberry and plum layer, abundant fine tannins, sweet oak flavour with a cashew nut flavours, medium+ acidity, feminine and lengthy finish. In short – a lovely example with a sense of elegance and refinement.*

*Drink now and through 2028.”*

## 2015 Schubert Marion's Vineyard Pinot Noir

*“Attractive and fine bouquet with aromas of sweet red cherry and heirloom strawberry, some plum and red berry fruits, sweet vanilla, powdered clove and toasty oak aromas, some more tart-like fruits also show with a cranberry and mangosteen suggestion. On the palate – youthful, ripe and tart fruit flavours with cherry, cranberry and mangosteen flavours; elevated acidity accentuates the tannins with a range of textures from youthful to fine; plenty of oak and lengthy finish. A wine that needs more time in cellar, but great potential all the same. Drink now if decanted or from 2019 through 2029.”*
