**TASTING NOTE**

Refreshing citrus characters, paired with flavours of vineyard peach and aromatic strawberries make this classic French style Rosé the perfect companion for even the hottest summer days.

PRODUCER

After graduating from the German Viticulture and Oenology University Geisenheim, Kai Schubert and Marion Deimling travelled the world in search of the perfect conditions for viticulture, especially their favourite variety – Pinot Noir. Their quest took them to the wine regions of France, Germany, Oregon, California, South America and Australia and ended in Martinborough in the beautiful Wairarapa Valley. Since 1998 Schubert Wines have been growing and producing wines with intense and complex character that are now nationally and internationally award winning.

VINEYARD INFORMATION

CLIMATIC CONDITIONS: Cool, damp weather during flowering, significantly reduced the yields. Conditions over the second half of the growing season were near to perfect, which delivered fantastic fruit into the winery.

VINIFICATION

Hand-picked, de-stemmed and cold-macerated on skins for 3 hours, then pressed and fermented in stainless steel tanks.

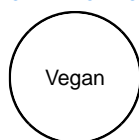
